



TUITION AND FEE SCHEDULE 2025-2026

Tuition: The tuition for the 2025–2026 school year is \$5,450 per student, billed in 10 monthly installments beginning August 1, 2025 (*the month prior to the start of school*).

Registration Fee: A non-refundable \$50 registration fee is required for each new and returning student to secure enrollment for the 2025–2026 school year.

School Supplies Fee: The cost of school supplies is included in tuition. HTPS will provide all required supplies, except for backpacks, water bottles, and lunchboxes.

Tuition and Fee Payments: All tuition and fees will be invoiced through Jupiter Tuition Management. Students will not be considered enrolled or eligible to attend classes until a Jupiter account is set up.

Payment Methods:

- **Cash** - No transaction fee. Payments can be dropped off at the school office.
- **Check** - Payable to "ROBC HTPS" with the student's name in the memo line. Drop off or mail to the school office. No transaction fees. (*Note: Fees for bounced checks are the payer's responsibility.*)
- **ACH (via Jupiter):** 1.9% transaction fee (maximum \$4).
- **Card (via Jupiter):** 2.9% + \$1 transaction fee (no fee limit).

Late Payment Fee: A \$50 late fee will be automatically applied if tuition is not paid by the 15th of the month.

Delinquent Accounts: Notifications will be sent at 30, 60, and 90 days past due. Accounts past due over 90 days will be referred to a third-party collections agency, with written notice provided before this step.

School-Wide Fundraising: Money raised will go into the general school fund. If tuition alone does not cover all operational expenses, a portion of the funds will be used to fill that gap. In the spirit of *милостыня*, up to 10% of the proceeds may be set aside to provide scholarships for families in need. Any remaining funds will then be applied toward reducing tuition for all students. The amount of tuition reduction will depend entirely on the success of fundraising efforts.

Volunteering: Parent involvement is essential to our school's success. As part of our mission to build a strong, Christ-centered community, we ask all families to take part in volunteering in some form. Just as we are called to give a tithe of our treasures, so too can we dedicate a portion of our time to serve Him and others.

HTPS Scholarship Program: HTPS is committed to supporting families experiencing financial hardship. If funds are available, we will provide a link to the application and policy.

Withdrawal from Enrollment: Any outstanding tuition and fees must be paid upon withdrawing a student from enrollment. If tuition was prepaid, a prorated refund will be issued based on the withdrawal date.
